- Marburg virus disease in Ghana: **02** cases detected and **02** deaths (100% case fatality) in the Ashanti region, southern Ghana.
- Guinea: declaration of the end of the Lassa fever epidemic



# Risk Analysis : Acute hepatitis of unknown aetiology in children

- Cause remains unknown but most cases positive to either adenovirus or SARS-CoV-2
- 2 new countries affected
- 1010 cases and 22 deaths (CFR 2%)
- Limited monitoring
- Limited epidemiological data









- 183 deaths recorded, lethality 1.9%


**DISTRIBUTION OF NEW CASE BY EPIDEMIOLOGICAL WEEK**



## Statistical data of PSF at EW 27

12126 passengers passed through the FSPs, 10891 tests were performed and 14 covid-19 positive cases notified. Accuracy = 45% and completeness = 58%.

- 12 positive cases at Airborne FSPs:**

HBP from Douala International Airport (4), from Cote d'Ivoire, Belgium, Gabon and Senegal;

HBP of Yaoundé Nsimalen International Airport (8), from France (2), Ivory Coast, Turkey, Ethiopia, Gabon, Nigeria and Switzerland.

- 01 positive case in the Maritime HBP:**






# ROAD TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS (RTA)
